I. Market Value as of September, 2020

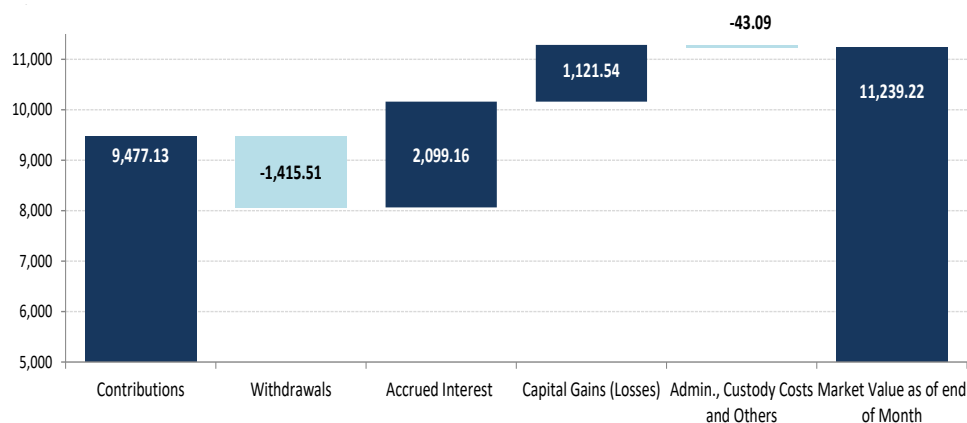
The market value of the Pension Reserve Fund (PRF) totaled US\$11,239.22 million at the end of the month. It changed due to: (i) accrued interests of US\$18.33 million, (ii) capital losses on investments of US\$214.63 million and (iii) administrative, custody and other costs of US\$0.98 million.

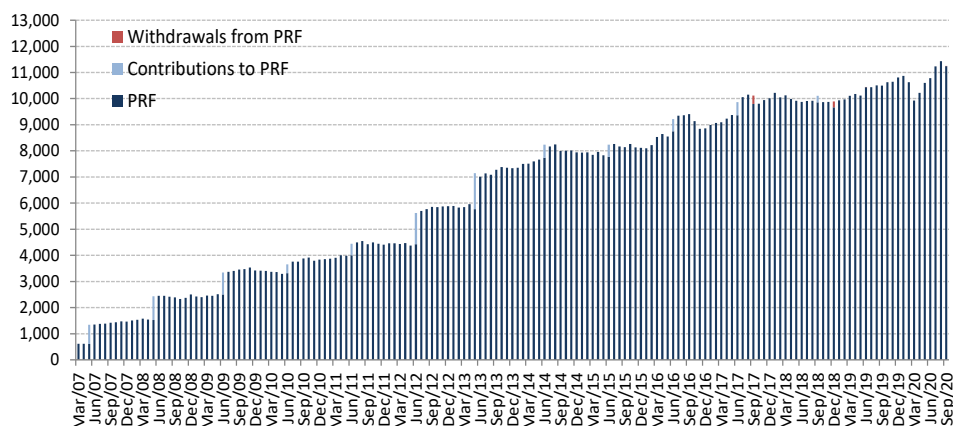

II. Return as of September

The net return in US dollars was -1.72% in the month. This is broken down in the returns of the Sovereign and Government Related Bonds, -0.17%, Inflation Indexed Sovereign Bonds, -1.15%, US Agencies MBS, -0.04%, Corporate Bonds, -0.96%, High Yield Bonds, -1.91%, and Equities, -4.22%. The returns in US dollars experienced by the Sovereign and Government Related Bonds and the Inflation Indexed Sovereign Bonds portfolios were explained by the impact of the depreciation (relative to the US dollar) of the currencies in which are invested. The returns in US dollars experienced by the US Agencies MBS and the High Yield Bonds portfolios were mainly explained by the negative impact of the interest rates. The return in US dollars experienced by the Corporate Bonds portfolio was explained by both negative impact of the interest rates, and by the impact of the depreciation (relative to the US dollar) of the currencies in which is invested. The Equities portfolio's return was mainly explained by the performance in local currency. Finally, the monthly return of the fund in pesos was -1.15%. Year to date return was 3.96% in US dollars and 9.52% in pesos, while the annualized return since inception was 3.96% in US dollars and 6.89% in pesos.

Returns for periods of more than one year are compound annualized rates while those for less than a year correspond to the change as seen in the stated period. With a view to meeting high standards of transparency and providing a better assessment of the gains or losses on investments, the Ministry of Finance discloses the fund's return in different time horizons and currencies. With respect to the horizon, it is important to note that, in keeping with the medium- and longterm investment policy, the return assessment should focus on that period, disregarding fluctuations that may occur monthly or quarterly. With regard to returns expressed in different currencies, the return in US dollars allows for an assessment which is more in line with the investment policy given that the fund's resources are wholly invested abroad and in foreign currency. The return in Chilean pesos is also disclosed. This return reflects changes in the peso-dollar exchange rate and, therefore, may experience greater fluctuations. Finally, as with any investment, returns obtained in the past do not guarantee future positive results.
