**MONTHLY EXECUTIVE REPORT**

**ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL STABILIZATION FUND**

**MARCH 2009**

The market value<sup>1</sup> of the Economic and Social Stabilization Fund (ESSF) as of March 31, 2009 was **US\$ 19,618.2 million**.

The ESSF was established on March 6, 2007, and since then its resources have been managed by the Central Bank of Chile, acting as fiscal agent according to the instructions of the Ministry of Finance.

Contributions to the ESSF since its creation total **US\$ 18,100 million**. According to this Ministry, withdrawals<sup>2</sup> from the fund totaled **US\$ 200 million** as of March 31, 2009.

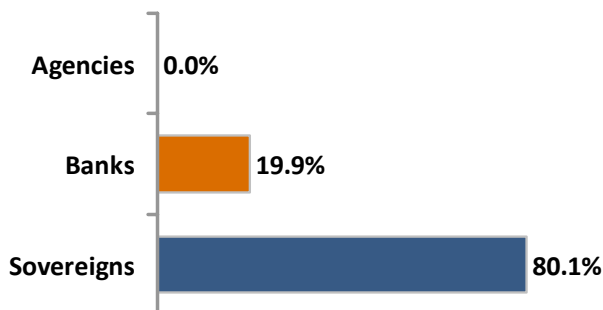
In March the ESSF investment portfolio earned **US\$ 47.3 million** in interest.

The following is a breakdown of the portfolio according to type of asset, duration and currency.

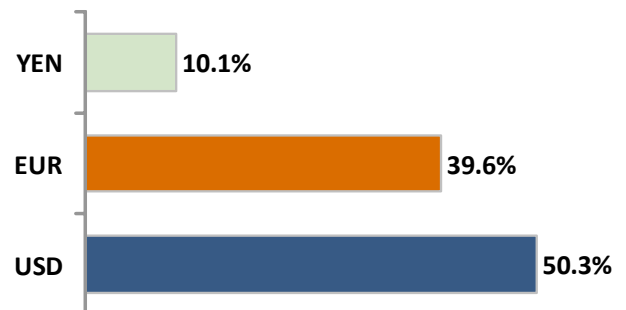
