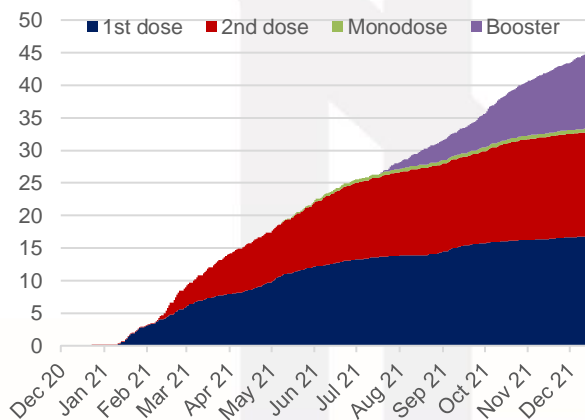

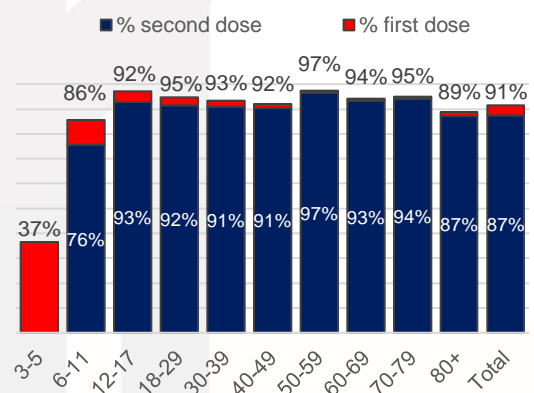
An Update on COVID-19 in Chile

More than 44.7 million vaccines have been administered, with 87.4% of the target population completing the process (67.8% in the population under 18 years and 92.2% in the population over 18 years). Chile stands out for being the country with the largest share of population vaccinated with booster doses, reaching 60 per 100 inhabitants. In total, 11.4 million booster doses have been administered.

Million

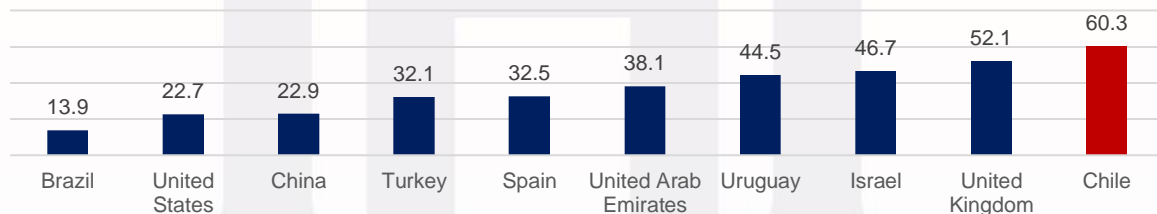


Administered Doses per Age Group
Percent of Target Population



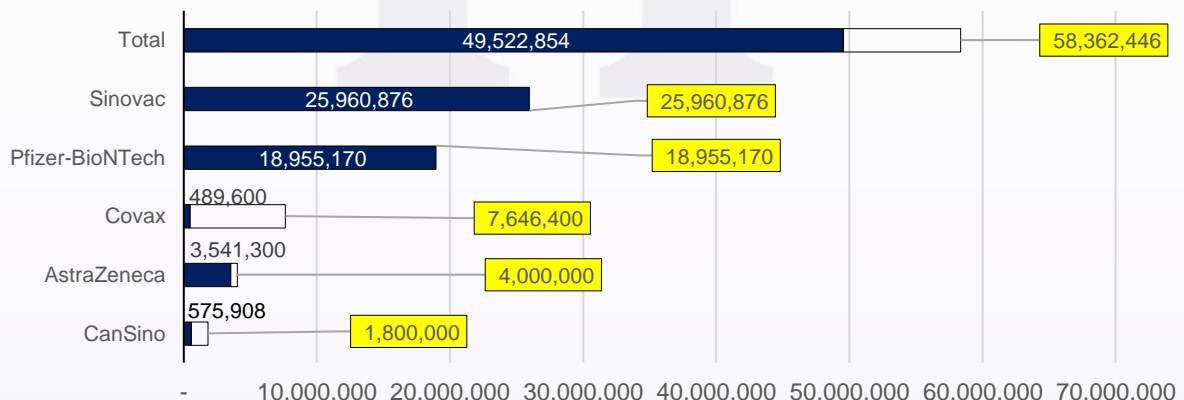
Booster Doses Administered

COVID-19 Vaccine Doses per Supplier: Received & Pending

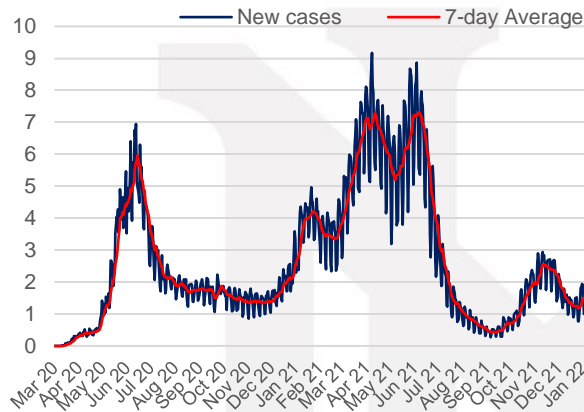

During last week cases have been increasing as well PCR test positivity rates. Both indicators still maintain at moderate levels.

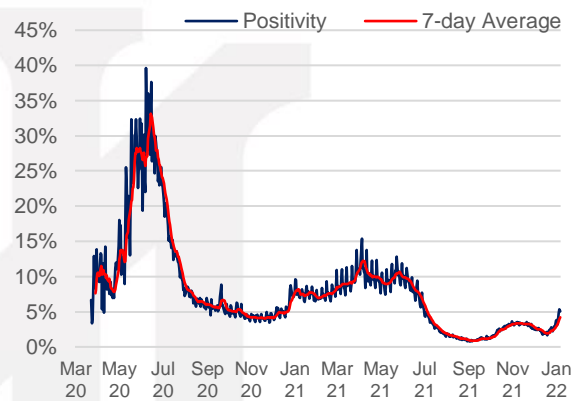
COVID-19 Cases in Chile

PCR Test Positivity Rate

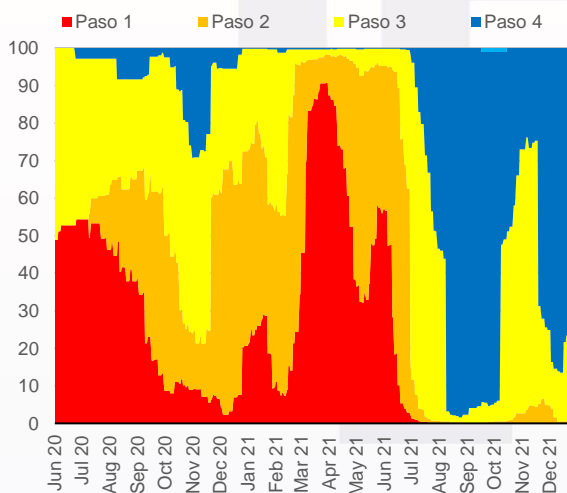

Currently, 76% of the national population is in Paso 4 (Step 4), with more than 6 regions reaching a 90% of its population in Paso 4 or Paso 5.

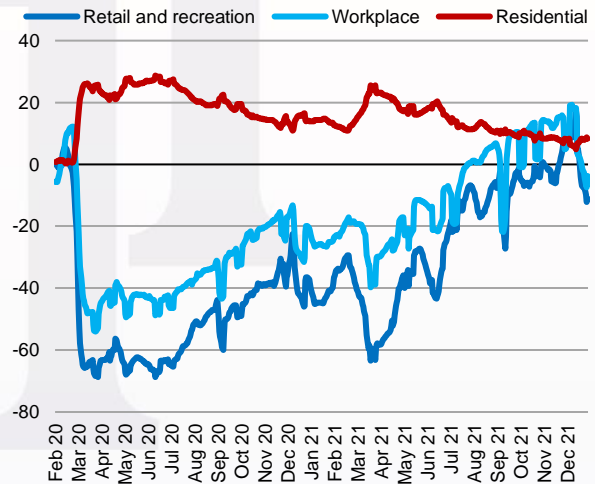
Share of Population per Phase

Percent deviation with respect to pre-Covid levels

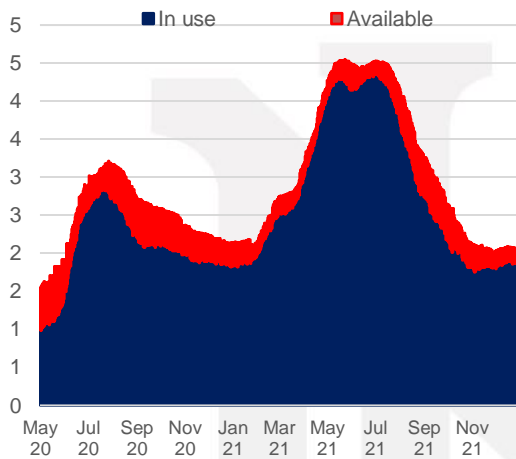

ICU patients have slightly increased, critical bed capacity has moderated.

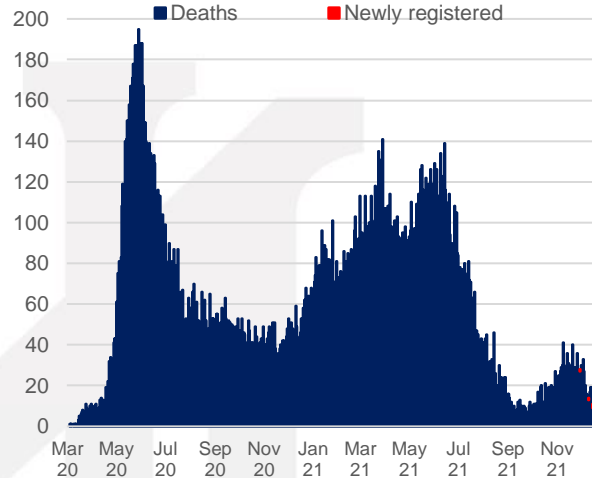
Critical beds

COVID-19 related Deaths

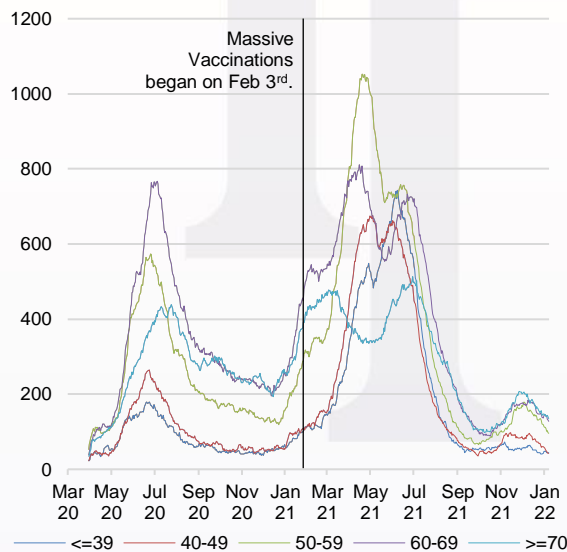

ICU patients by Age Group in Chile

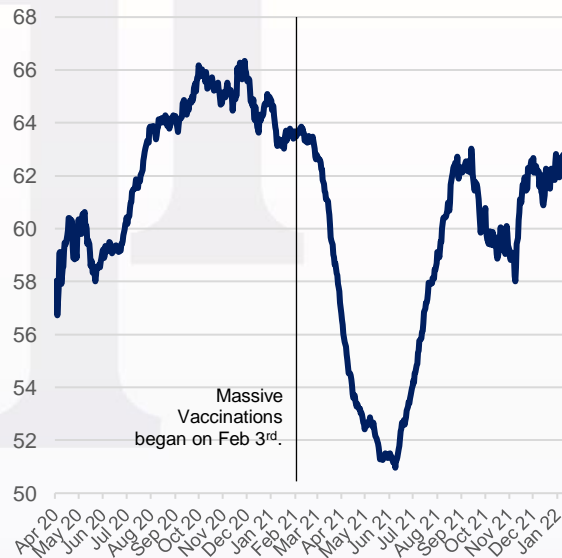
